

## Reverse Parallel Parking as per Victorian p plate Drive Test.

Accurate as at July 2010-10-17

You are allowed 7 metres. This process is not a standard reverse parallel park.

Your car should be moving very slowly during the entire process

Stop beside car A front of your car just past front of car A

Reverse straight back until u can see the rear/end of car A in your rear left passenger side window.

Turn your steering wheel 1 full turn to the left. (360 degrees)

When your car reaches a 30 degree angle (1 o'clock)

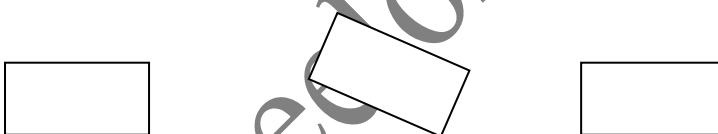
Turn your steering wheel 1 turn to the right, (360 degrees)

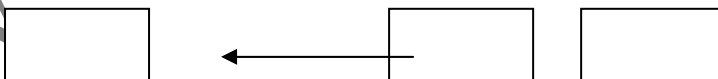
Reverse until your left rear wheel is close to where the road meets the gutter

Turn your steering wheel 1 turn away from the gutter



---

Reverse until your car is parallel with the gutter and stop



---

Move forward straightening your wheels as you move forward stopping when you are 1 to 2 metres from car A
